

TSE Terms & Conditions

Stand Reservation/Allocation

The exhibitor must apply for a stand by returning the completed and signed Official Order Form, together with the total remittance or purchase order, to Tourism South East (TSE).

Stands are allocated subject to availability. TSE reserves the right to refuse without explanation the allocation of a stand. The position of each stand within the Exhibition will be at the discretion of the Board.

Subletting

No part or whole of any site may be sublet by any exhibitor without prior written permission from the TSE.

Consortia

In the case of every site booked by a Consortium of Exhibitors, at least 50% of the Consortium must be a member of a Regional Tourist Board.

Health and Safety

All standholders must ensure that their stand complies with Health and Safety regulations.

Insurance & Security

The exhibitor should ensure that all stand items are covered by full and comprehensive insurance. The TSE cannot accept responsibility for any losses incurred. The Exhibitor is required to effect public liability insurance.

Exclusion of Liability

The TSE and its employees shall not be liable for any loss, theft or damage to property during the terms of this agreement from any cause whatsoever.

Indemnity

The Exhibitor shall defend TSE from and indemnify against any claim or liability for injury to persons or property arising from any cause whatsoever in connection with his participation at the Exhibition by the Exhibitors, his agents, contractors or employees. The Exhibitor should also ensure that he has adequate insurance to cover all liabilities and rights.

Gangways, Fire Protection areas and Exits

All gangways, fire protection areas and exits must be kept clear at ALL times.
